The first two Saturdays went well, with a nice crowd on opening day, May 31st, with a paid attendance of 584. That compares favorably to Saturday of June 1st of 2007 when we had a paid attendance of 398. On Saturday, June 7th, the paid attendance was 326 compared to a year ago of 306 and then we had the Belmont simulcast. The handle on May 31, '08 was \$21,119.00 which compares favorably to a year ago of live handle \$19,845.00 plus \$3,330.00 from Belmont. On June 7th the live handle was \$16,463.00 compared to a live handle in '07 of \$15,060 but the handle on the Belmont in '07 was \$14,848.00.

We've had lots of rain, storms, etc., but so far it has cleared on race day. Opening day it was overcast, threatening, etc., but a nice breeze without any lightning or other developing weather conditions. The track has held up remarkably well considering the heavy and consistent rains. We've lost quite a bit of sand but the base has held up well. Thankfully, we have not had any lockey injuries to date and no horse has received life threatening injury.

The seven race card on both days was made up of 8, 9, & 10 horse fields with an adequate jockey colony to accommodate with one exception in an 870 race where it was the first time the horse had entered at that distance. The program for tomorrow is equally solid. On the first day we had 87entries with 22 TB & 33 QH horses(no App nor Pt) drawing in to the seven races(we're only able to run 8 horse fields in our 870's and TB races). On June 7th we had 100 entries, using 59 which was made up of 23 TB & 31 QH (again no App nor Pt) with five scratches. We had 86 entries for June 14th, 61 drawing in made up of 23 TB & 38 QH(again no App nor Pt). Hopefully entries will continue to remain strong as they are up considerably from last years average of 6.7 horses per race and 46.9 horses per day.

Dear Mr. Martino:

Due to the anticipated purse money that will be available for our upcoming horse meet, we would like to request KRGC approval to adjust our 2008 race dates at the Woodlands. We propose a 26 day horse meet beginning September 20, 2008 and continuing through October 25, 2008. Race days would be Saturday through Wednesday with a 12:30 PM post. Reducing the race days this year from 32 to 26 will ensure that our purses are at the levels of 2007 and possibly a slight increase. With the shortage of horses this time of year, we feel this is the best decision to attract horsemen. We have notified the horsemen groups and the kennels and they have given their support.

Additionally, with our low active list, instead of running a double header, we would like to run a single greyhound performance with a 4:00 PM post on Thursdays during the horse meet. Upon completion of the horse meet on October 26th, our greyhound schedule would return to normal.

When we initially submitted our race dates for 2008, we had anticipated having our casino operational. Since this has not happened, we would like to adjust our racing schedule as follows:

November 27, 2008 (Thanksgiving): Dark completely;

December 18, 2008 through December 21, 2008: Run live greyhounds with our normal schedule;

December 22, 2008 through December 25, 2008 (Christmas Break): Dark completely; December 26, 2008: Run a live greyhound matinee performance only at 1:00 PM, with no evening performance.

We believe these changes are in the best interest of all parties.

I have attached a revised 2008 racing schedule with the changes highlighted and noted for your review.
